



Pre-Prep School Clubs for Summer Term 2017

Dear Parents,

As you know our after school and lunch time clubs are extremely popular with both Year 1 and 2 pupils. Please take time to look at the selection of clubs on offer below. Children who are interested should select their first and possible second choice by filling in the attached application forms.

On Monday 13th March children should make their way to the club leader's classroom to enrol when the school opens at 8.25am.

Clubs will run from Monday 24th April – Friday 30th June 2017

(excluding Monday 1st May, INSET day Friday 26th May and half term 29th May – 2nd June)

Club Enrolment Procedure

- Return applications will be accepted from 8.25 am on **Monday 13th March** and NOT before.
- All returned applications MUST be delivered to the CLUB LEADER direct, in their classrooms – (this information is clearly marked next to club details).
- Please note – if a club is oversubscribed on the actual morning of Monday 13th March, Year 2 pupils will be given priority and ALL Year 1 names will be placed into a hat and drawn for remaining places.
- If a club is NOT oversubscribed places will be filled on a first come, first served basis over the following days.
- A club overview sheet outlining all the clubs and places taken by children will be CLEARLY displayed on both the entry door to the Yr 1 and 2 building and on the Parents' Notice Board in the playground. This will be available from **Wednesday 15th March** and amended each day thereafter.

Places will only be secured for teacher run clubs with a completed form.

- **Clubs marked in blue** are run by an outside agency. Payment is made direct to them. Cheques for drama club may be handed into Mrs Mitchell. These will be forwarded. If payment is not received in full before half term, the place will be terminated. Please note that Chess payments must be sent directly to the club runner.
- **Clubs marked in red** are run by school staff. No payment is made now. You will instead be invoiced for this club. Each club costs £90.00. Numbers are restricted depending on club.
- **Year 1's may only do 2 afternoon clubs and 1 lunch time club.**
- **Years 2's may do 3 afternoon clubs and 1 lunch time club.**

- 2) You will receive a reply to confirm if they have secured a place or not*. If your child is successful you will also be sent details regarding payment options.
- 3) **Payment must be made before the first session - Tuesday 25th April.**
Failure to pay on time means your child can not attend the club and their place will be offered to the first child on the waiting list.

*if your child does not get a place they will be placed on the waiting list

PLEASE NOTE: Forms left at school will NOT be registered.

Chess club starts on 25th April and runs every Tuesday, excluding half term, until 27th June and the cost is £100 per child per term.
