



IT AND MATHS TEACHER

We are a co-educational independent school catering for boys and girls aged 7+ to 13+.

We broadly follow the National Curriculum but from Year 5 the children are taught by specialist teachers and the curriculum is then geared towards the demands of the 11+ and 13+ entry exams to independent secondary schools.

We are looking for a well-qualified secondary trained teacher who is able to teach IT to a range of year groups (Years 5 to 9) and Maths (to 13+ scholarship level) and ideally has experience of the British independent system. The ability to convey enthusiasm for both these subjects is important as is the ability to teach the more “maths phobic” children as well as those who are more mathematical able.

We have our own salary scale which is broadly similar to that of the state sector. We have our own personal pension scheme to which the employer contributes up to 5% of the gross salary of the employee as long as this is met with an equal contribution from the employee.

We shall interview those candidates who are short-listed and they will be expected to teach both a Maths and a IT lesson at that interview. Details of what is to be taught will of course be sent to those short-listed candidates.
