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Sports & PE Teacher An outline job description

PE is taught in line with but not restricted to the National Curriculum, to Year 3 to Year 8 pupils in mixed ability classes of 16-20 pupils.

The candidate should be a qualified and experienced PE teacher. The ideal candidate should be able to teach team sports to both boys and girls and have a specialism in gymnastics and dance.

The person appointed will:

- teach physical education to pupils in Years 3-8 (single-sex and co-educational)
- teach some PE & Sports to Year 2 children at our Pre-Prep
- assist with the running of sports tours (nationally and internationally)
- be prepared to contribute to the wider life of the school
- readily contribute to and take responsibility for curriculum development and resources as requested
- assist the Head of Department in areas of departmental organisation and development
- organise and supervise sports fixtures both home and away. This may on occasions involve fixtures which take place on a Saturday morning.
- ensure all fixtures are entered correctly on the school calendar and team lists are kept up to date on the school intranet.
- keep the Head of Department informed of all matters arising from and relating to the department and classes taught
- attend parents' evenings, departmental, pastoral and staff meetings
- be prepared to be a form tutor and carry out break and lunch time duties
